

Prom Dress Code Guidelines

School dress code will be followed for piercings, tattoos, shaving, and undergarments.

Gentlemen should be dressed appropriately for the event.

Dress guidelines for ladies:

- Short dresses must be at least fingertip length and long enough so that the rear end stays completely covered while walking, dancing, or bending over.
- Slits in skirts should be no higher than fingertip length, even if bloomers or tights are worn underneath.
- Strapless, spaghetti-strap, or one-shoulder dresses are fine as long as the entire chest area is covered.
- Open-back dresses are fine as long as the back is open to the waist only.
- Two-piece dresses are allowed provided they meet the following conditions:
 - Tops may not be strapless.
 - Skirts must be worn at the waist.
 - No more than two (2) inches of midriff may be visible.
